Indeed the end of the Cold War generated hopes for a new world order and predictions that economics would replace geopolitics as the driving force in international politics. However as Sempa points out Russian instability, the nuclear dimension of the India-Pakistan conflict and Chinese bids for dominance have turned the Asia Pacific region into what Mahan called debatable and debated ground. Russia, Turkey, Iran, India, Pakistan, China, Japan, the Koreas and the United States all have interests that collide in one or more of the areas of this region. The timeliness and deep historical perspective of Sempa's analysis will remind statesmen, strategists and interested citizens that the current world situation will not last forever. The defeat of one would be hegemonic power is likely to be followed by a new challenger or challengers to current stability in the international system.
