Hungarian Soldier vs Soviet Soldier Péter Mujzer, 2021-07-22 On 26 June 1941 unidentified bombers attacked the Hungarian town of Kassa prompting Hungary to join its Axis partners in Operation Barbarossa Hitler's invasion of the Soviet Union Hungary's contribution to Barbarossa was designated the Carpathian Group its most powerful component being the Mobile Corps which fielded motorized rifle cavalry bicycle and light armoured troops The Hungarians faced Soviet forces belonging to the Kiev Military District deployed in four armies along a 940km long front On the defeated side in World War I Hungary had seen its borders redrawn and its armed forces constrained by treaty but was determined to recover territories lost to adjoining countries When Hungary decided to participate in Operation Barbarossa however the Royal Hungarian Army was deployed in the Soviet Union and not against its neighbours Meanwhile the Red Army while remaining among the most formidable armies of the era had been seriously weakened by successive purges its shortcomings exposed by the Winter War against Finland in 1939-40 During the opening battles 4-13 July the Hungarian motorized rifle and armoured units clashed with the withdrawing Red Army forces In the battle for Uman 15 July-8 August the Hungarians blocked the Soviet troops' efforts to break out from encirclement During the Hungarian defensive operation at the River Dniepr 30 August-6 October counter-attacking Soviet units exerted heavy pressure on the defending Hungarians Both sides would seek to draw lessons from these opening battles as the war in the East continued to rage into 1942 Fully illustrated this book investigates the Hungarian and Soviet soldiers who fought in three battles of the Barbarossa campaign casting new light on the role played by the forces of Nazi Germany's allies on the Eastern Front

By the third week in February 1941 680 000 German soldiers were stationed on the Romanian-Soviet border. In preparation for the attack Hitler moved 3.2 million German and about 500 000 Axis soldiers to the Soviet border, launched many aerial surveillance missions over Soviet territory and stockpiled materiel in the East. The Soviets were still taken by surprise, mostly due to Stalin's belief that the Third Reich was unlikely to attack only two years after signing the Molotov-Ribbentrop Pact. The Soviet leader also believed the Nazis would be likely to finish their war with Britain before opening a new front. He refused to believe repeated warnings from his intelligence services on the Nazi buildup, fearing the reports to be British misinformation designed to spark a war between Germany and the USSR. Spy Dr Richard Sorge gave Stalin the exact German launch date. Swedish cryptanalysts led by Arne Beurling also knew the date beforehand but Sorge and other informers e.g. from the Berlin Police department had previously given different invasion dates which passed peacefully before the actual invasion. In addition, British intelligence gathering information through Ultra warned the Soviet Union of impending invasion several months prior to 22 June 1941. The Germans set up deception operations from April 1941 to add substance to their claims that Britain was the real target. Operations Haifisch and Harpune. These simulated preparations in Norway, the Channel coast and Britain. There were supporting activities such as ship concentrations, reconnaissance flights and training exercises. Some details of these bogus invasion plans were deliberately leaked. German military planners also researched Napoleon's failed invasion of Russia. Barbarossa Army Group Center 22 June 1941 Atenas Asociados,1999-10-08 At the beginning of May 1933 the new National Socialist Government made its first attempt to come to an understanding with Poland But from the very outset it left no doubt that the permanent preservation of peace between the two nations was unthinkable as long as the Versailles boundaries were retained Also it refused to recognize that Poland had a special right to Danzig Nevertheless in spite of all this negotiations between the two countries led on January 26 1934 to a declaration that in the future they would under no circumstances use force for the settlement of any future disputes G 37 However in spite of this agreement German Polish relations remained more or less the same as before On November 5 1937 Germany and Poland concluded a new agreement for the mutual protection of minorities But the expected improvement in the condition of the German communities in Poland still failed to take place and unemployment especially among the youth steadily increased The Germans felt this to be especially hard since in the Reich Hitler had managed within a few years to put an end to unemployment The situation in Danzig demands special consideration Under the Versailles Treaty Danzig and its immediate vicinity had been separated from Germany and made into a Free City and its external political relations placed under a League of Nations Commissioner Poland was given certain special economic and transport privileges while on the Westerplatte an island at the mouth of the Vistula she had the right to maintain a fixed number of troops for the protection of a munitions depot An economic agreement between Danzig and Poland signed in August 1933 if loyally carried out might have brought about a lessening of the friction But the Polish Government besides building up the purely Polish port of Gdynia held fast to its expansionist policy toward Danzig and tried by unjustified tariff policies to deflect commerce from the Free City Polish propaganda even demanded the annexation of Danzig In spite of Poland s intransigent attitude Germany continued to seek an understanding concerning Danzig and the Corridor Towards this end the German Foreign Office made certain concrete proposals at the end of 1938 In these Poland was asked to agree to the return of Danzig and to the establishment of an extraterritorial highway and railway connection across the Corridor to East Prussia In return Germany was to give Poland a similar connection with Danzig and when the agreement came into effect definitely to recognize Poland s boundaries
